

at the hearing. Previously, Petitioner had tooth 31, a molar on the bottom right, extracted. The regulations discuss the circumstances for authorizing an implant. N.J.A.C. 10:56-2.13(c). The Initial Decision sets forth Dr. Rosen's testimony regarding the basis for the denial with regard to Petitioner's dental records and concludes that the extenuating circumstances set forth the regulations do not exist. As such there is no basis to approve the services requested and the authorization was properly denied.

THEREFORE, it is on this 18th day of AUGUST 2020,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED.
