

This matter arises from Notice of Claim and Withholding filed against Olshins Pharmacy after a pharmacy inventory analysis conducted by the Office of the State Comptroller, Medicaid Fraud Division. (MFD) identified \$23,383.43 in claims submitted from December 1, 2011 through December 1, 2016 that could not be supported by pharmaceutical wholesale invoices. Petitioner appealed the denial and the matter was transmitted to OAL.


During the hearing process, the parties agreed to a settlement and entered into a written agreement resolving the contested matter.

In the Initial Decision, the ALJ approved the Settlement Agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1. Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

That the Initial Decision is hereby ADOPTED.
