DID YOU KNOW?



- Almost 50% of the individuals who die by suicide saw a health practitioner within 30 days of their death?
- That the great majority of individuals over the age of 65 who die by suicide have seen a health practitioner within 30 days?
- Research has found a direct correlation between unemployment and deaths by suicide and that as unemployment increases deaths by suicide increase?
- A CDC survey conducted since the onset of COVID-19 found that almost 11% of adults had seriously considered suicide in the last month?
- That deaths by suicide are preventable?

Organizations that participate in one of the three Academies, each of which consists of three half-day (8:30 am – 12:30 pm) virtual training sessions, will be able to implement practices that prevent suicides in those that they serve.

The Zero Suicide Academies will present SAMHSA recommended tools and interventions, and the NJ Academies will also special focus on firearm safety and suicide by firearm presented by the Rutgers School of Public Health, Center on Gun Violence Research.
