human bite breaking the skin, injury around the eye such as bruising, swelling or laceration.								
Major injury: Refers to an injury that requires treatment that can only be performed at a hospital facility								
and may or may not include admission to the hospital for additional treatment or observation. Examples of								
major injuries include, but are not limited to, skull fractures, injuries to the eye (excluding the area around								
	the eye), and broken bones requiring setting and casting.
