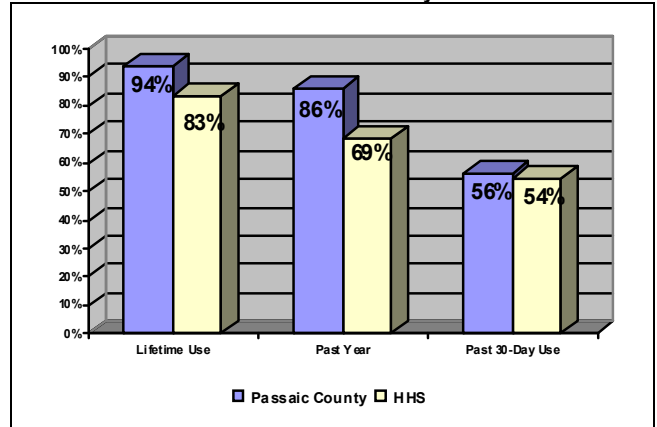

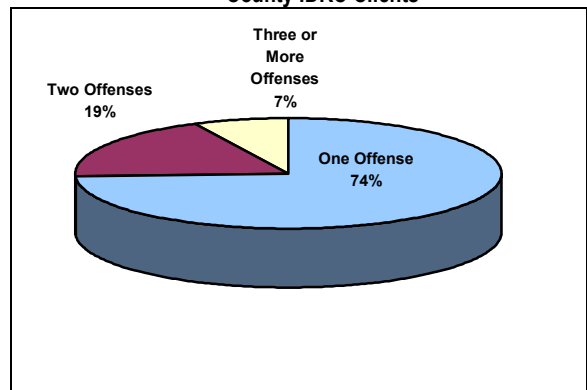

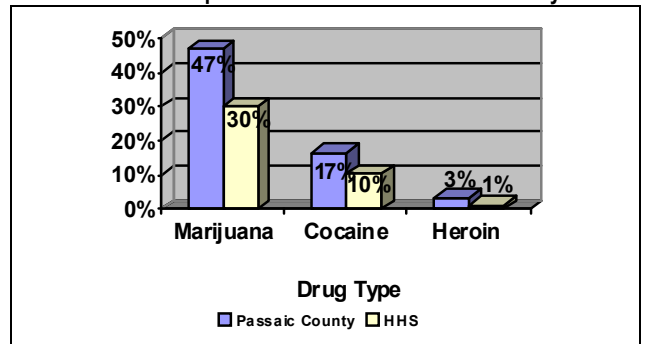
Alcohol Use by Passaic County IDRC Clients Compared with 2009 NJ Household Survey



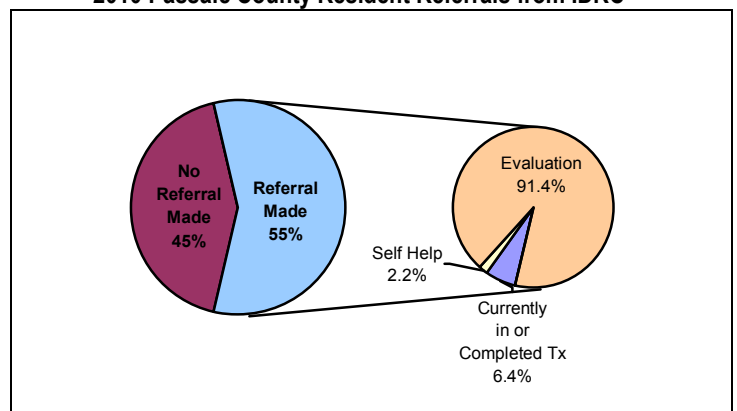
Number of Alcohol-Related Offenses on DMV Records of Passaic County IDRC Clients

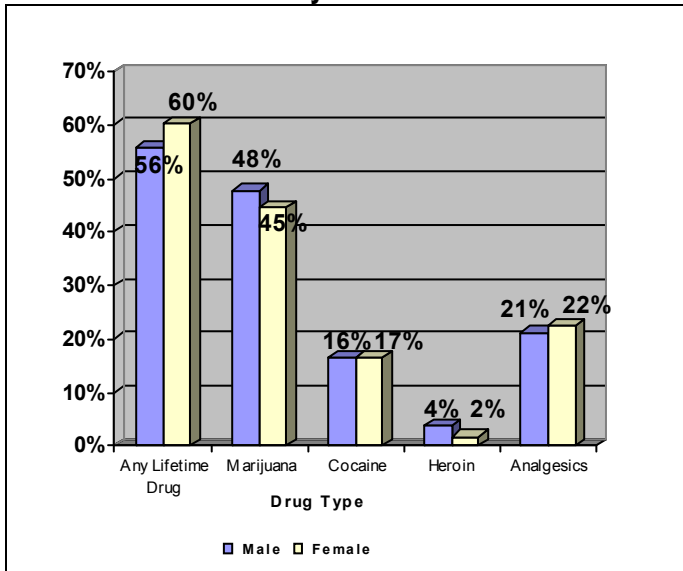
