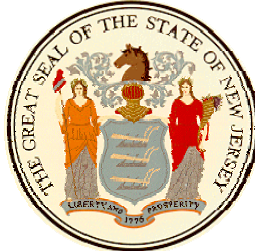

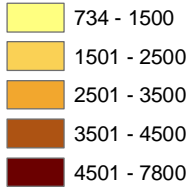

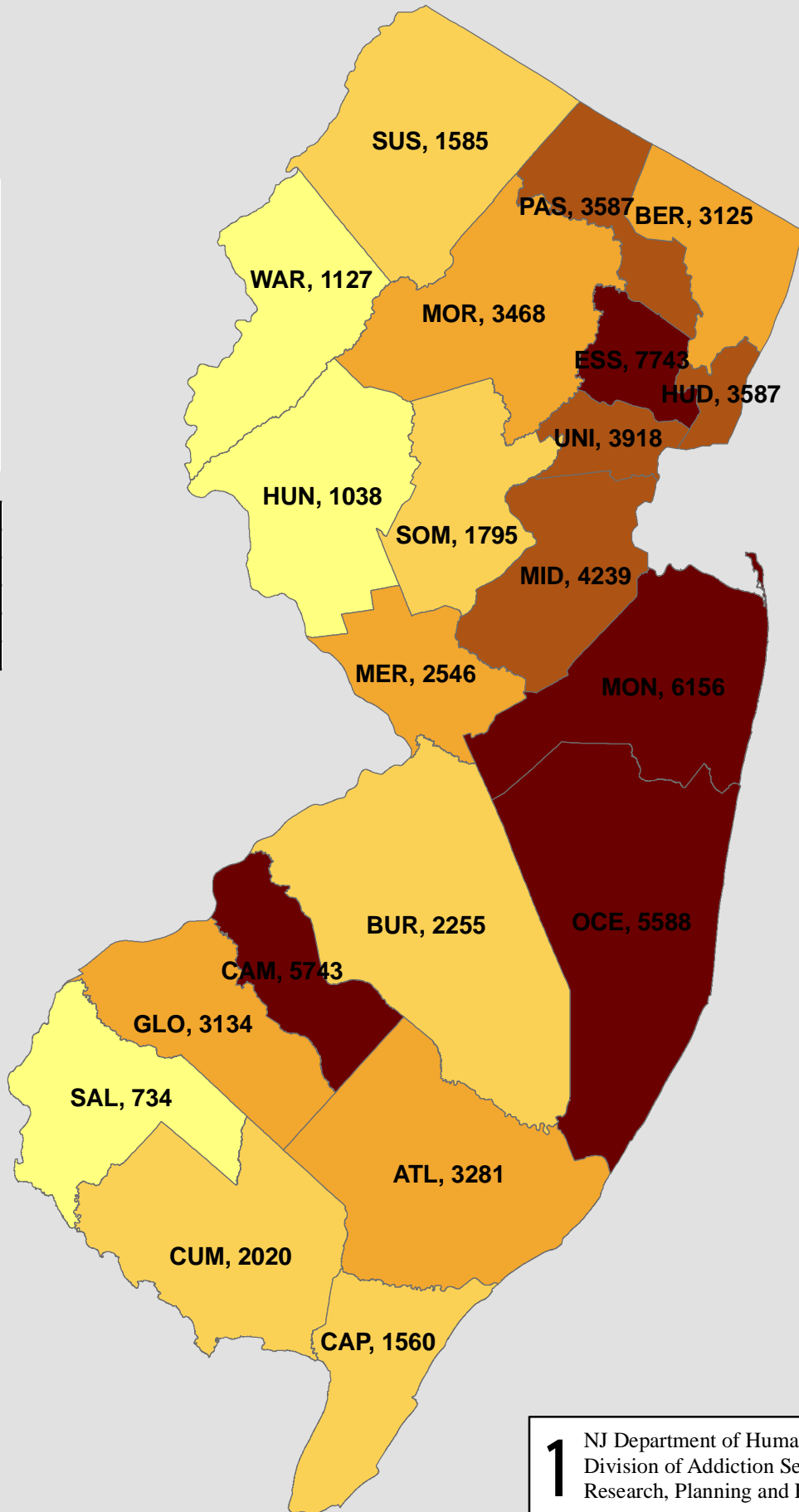
2009 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

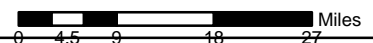

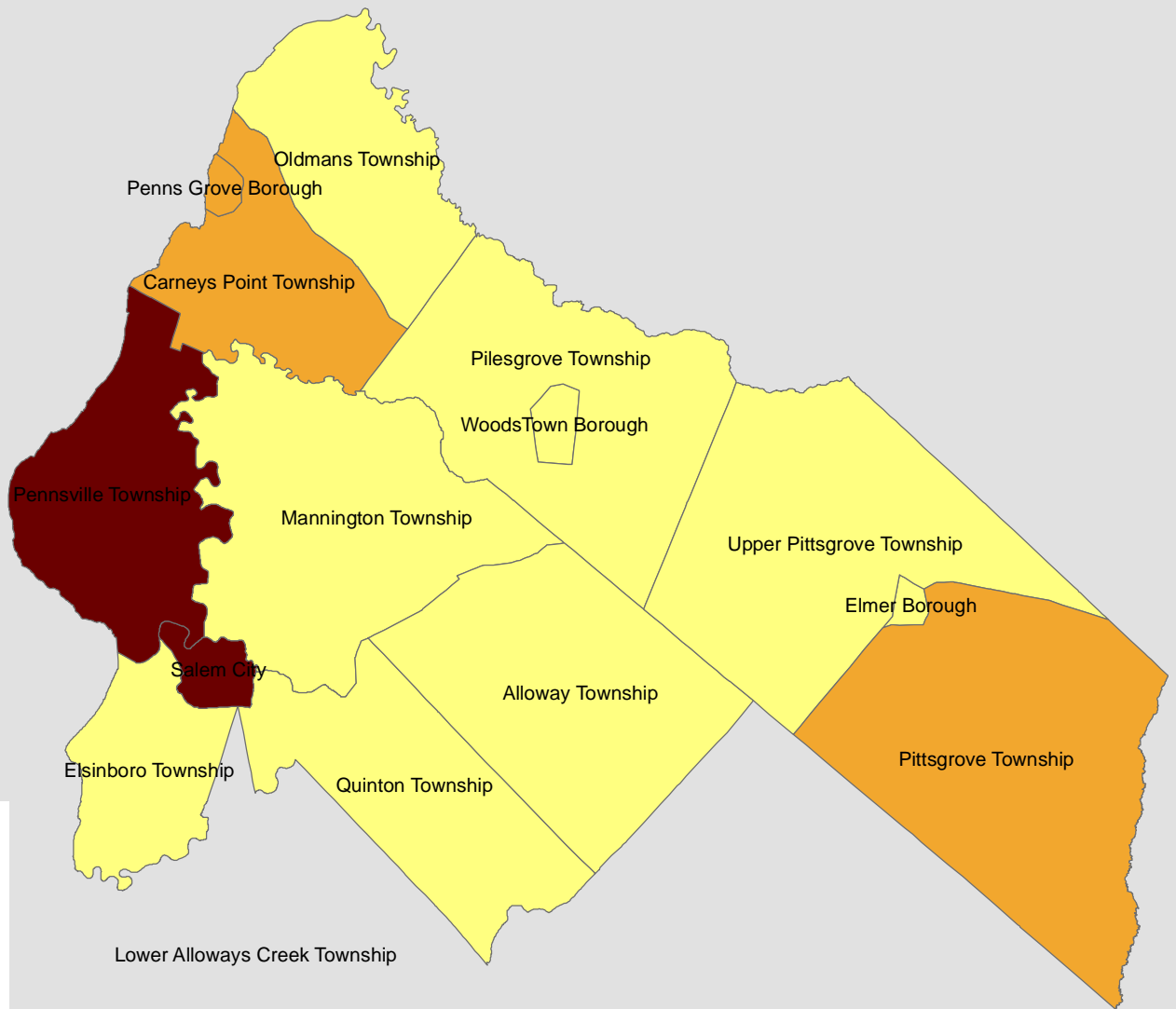

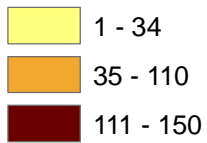
