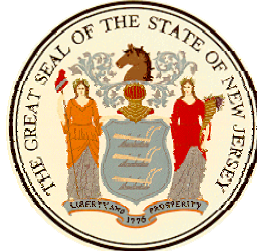

This ***Substance Abuse Overview*** provides statistics on substance abuse treatment in each New Jersey county for calendar year 2009. In 2009 there were 69,477 treatment admissions and 65,288 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 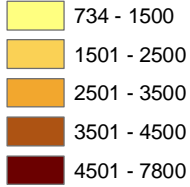

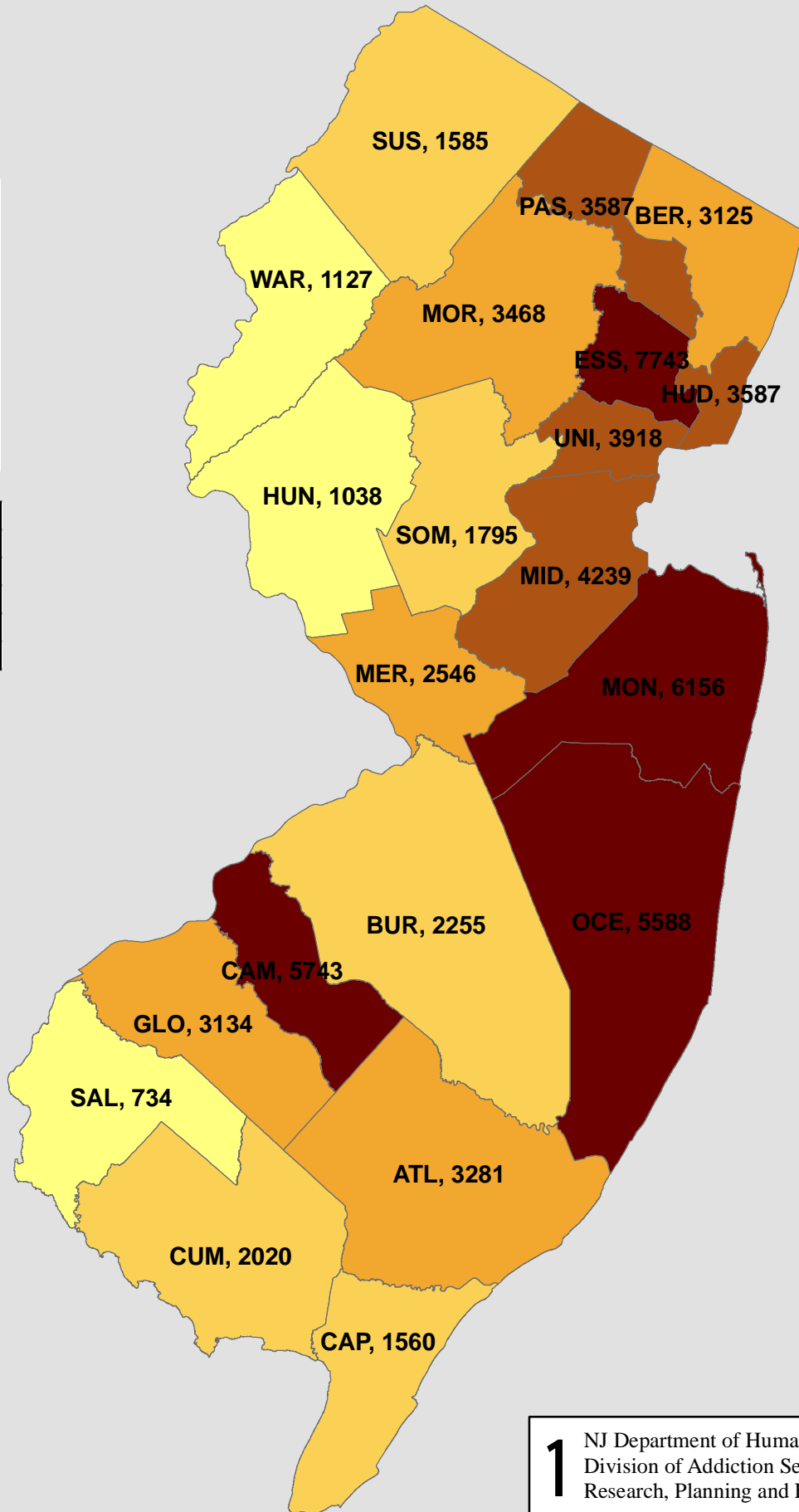
# 2009 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

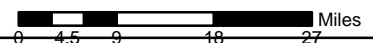

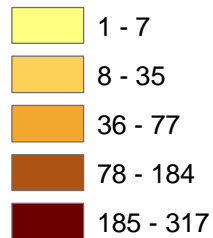

# 2009 Sussex County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence

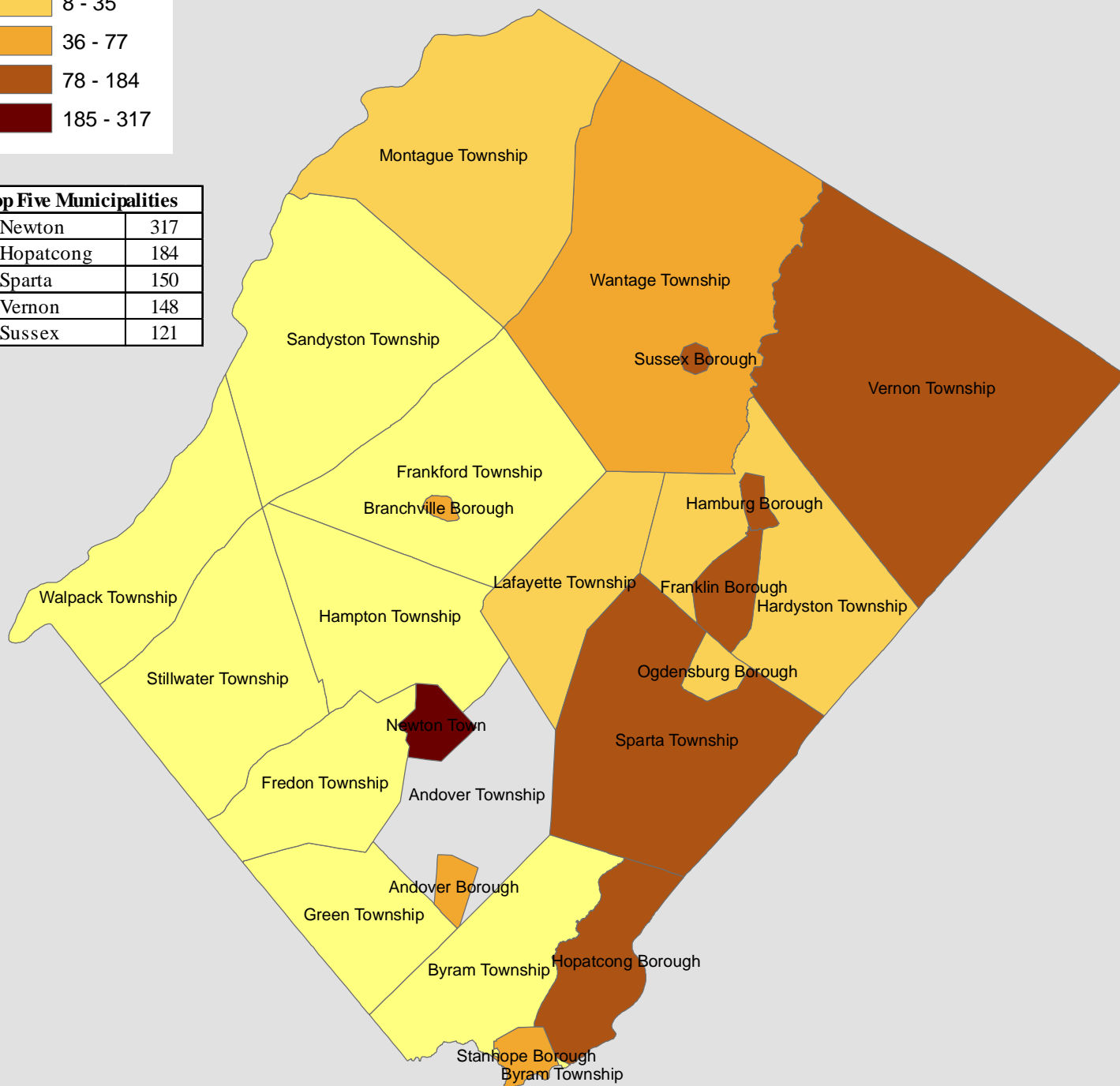
