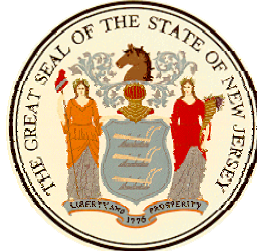

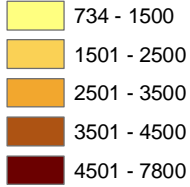

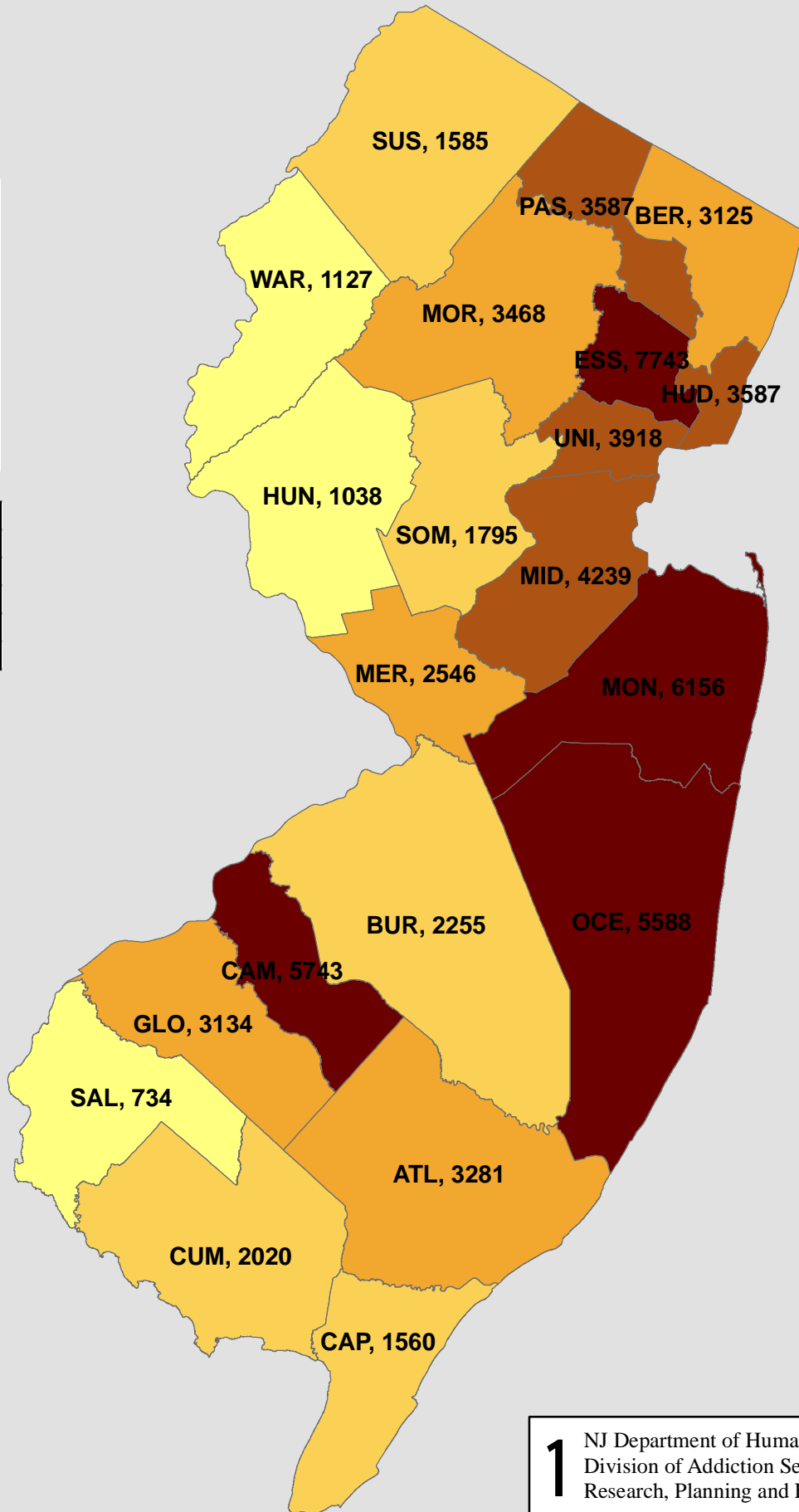
2009 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

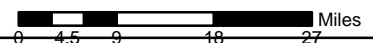

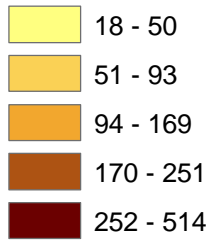

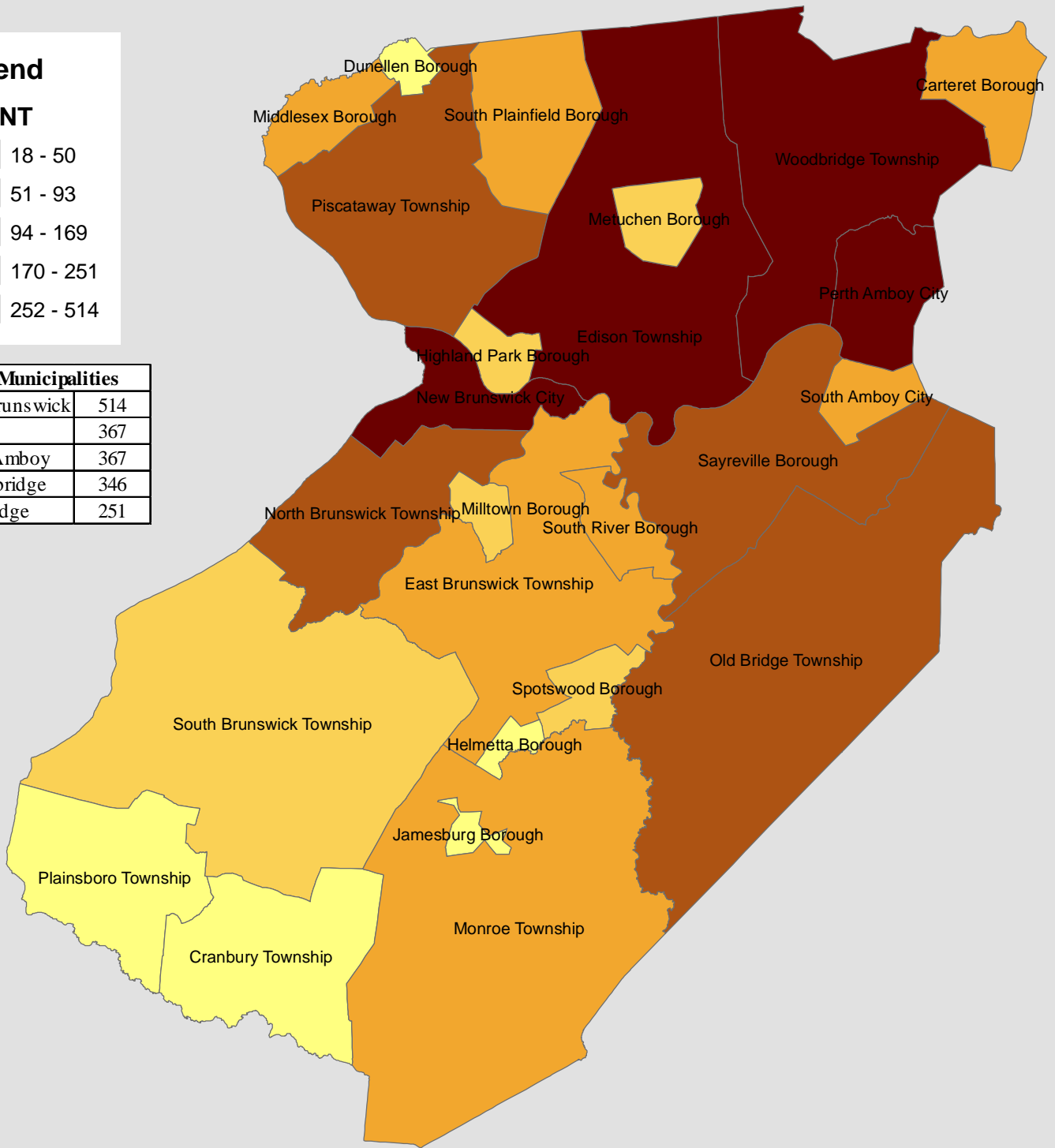
2009 Middlesex County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
