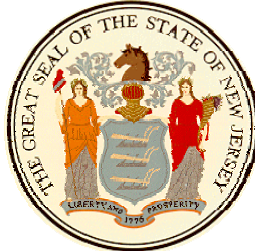

In 2009 there were 69,477 treatment admissions and 65,288 discharges reported to the New Jersey Department of Human Services, Division of Addiction Services by substance abuse treatment providers. 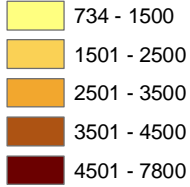

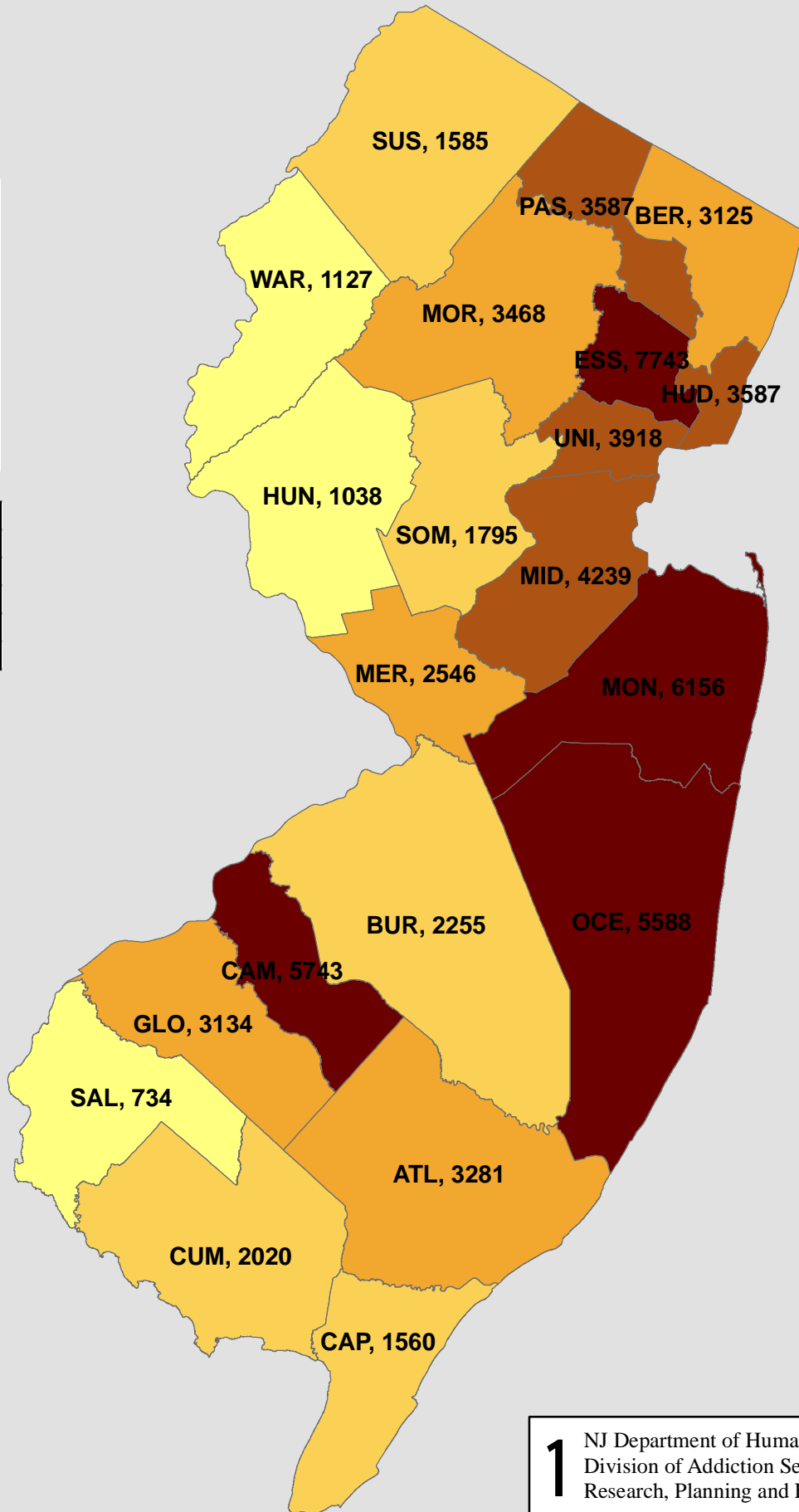
# 2009 Substance Abuse Admissions by County of Residence

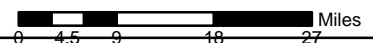

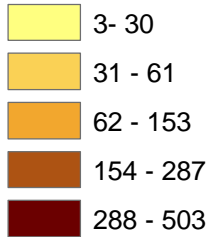

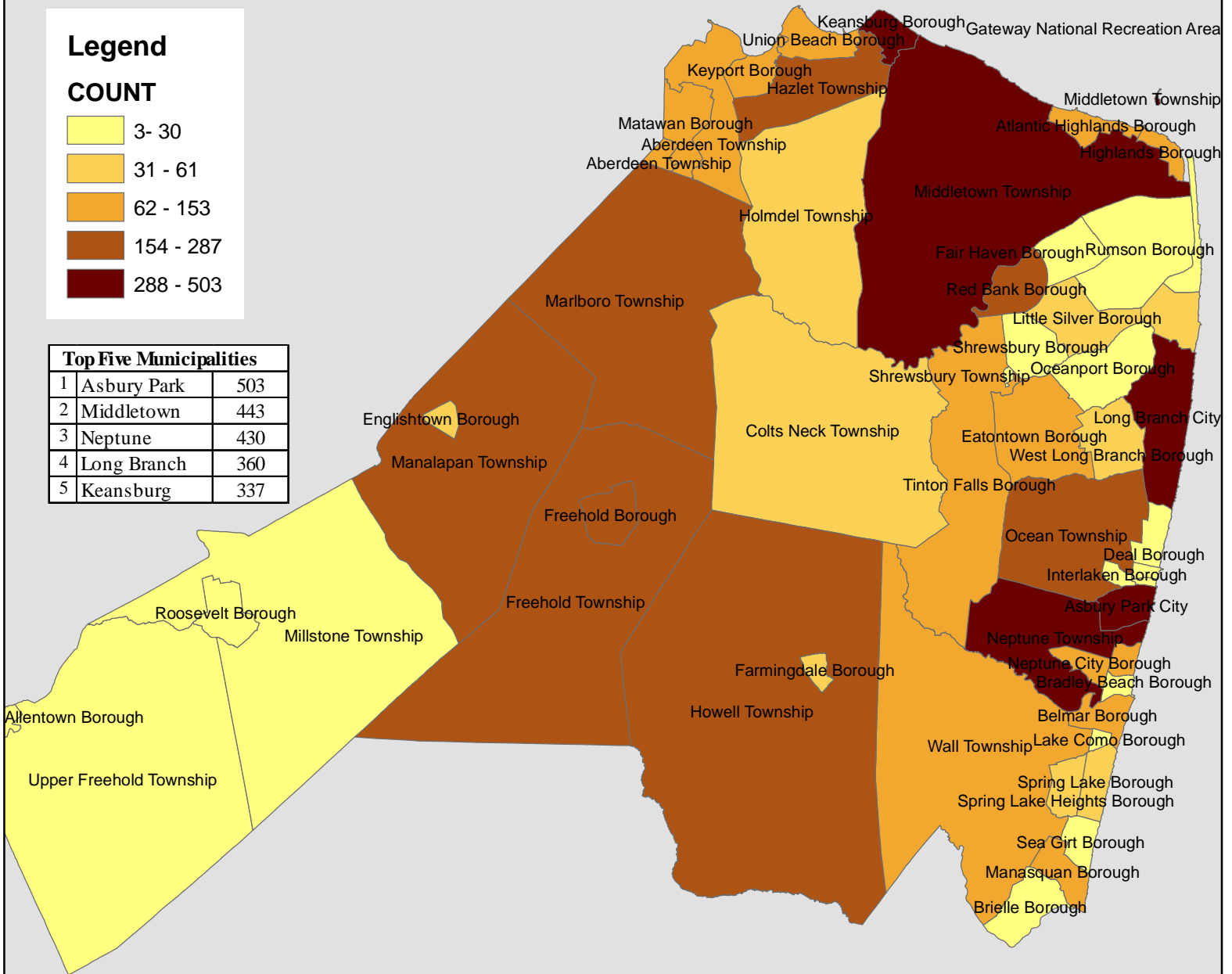
# 2009 Monmouth County Substance Abuse Admissions by Municipality of Residence
