As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the Initial Decision, the OAL case file and the documents in evidence. No exceptions were filed in this matter. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Agency Decision is October 14, 2014, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision in this matter was received on August 28, 2014.

This matter concerns the denial of Petitioner's Medicaid application due to excess resources. Petitioner applied and was approved for Medicaid on August 1, 2013. On April 16, 2014, Bergen County Board of Social Services (BCBSS) discovered that Petitioner had sold an undisclosed piece of property and requested a copy of the property settlement. On July 23, 2014, BCBSS notified Petitioner that her IRA account of \$10,341.26 and her annuity of \$10,433.37 put

The Medicaid resource eligibility limit is \$4,000 for an individual. N.J.A.C. 10:72-4.5(b). Petitioner clearly exceeds the limit. At the hearing, Petitioner was unable to offer any explanation as to why she should be eligible for benefits.

her over the resource limit of \$4,000. As a result, \$4,079.57 in Medicaid benefits

After reviewing the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and ADOPT the Initial Decision in its entirety.
