**The MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB™ LOTTERY GAME FINAL DRAWING
WAS HELD ON December 26, 2014**
Game Sales Nationwide Came In Below Industry Projections

TRENTON, N.J. (Dec. 30, 2014) – The final drawing of the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB lottery game was held on Dec. 26. Due to low ticket sale performance across the 23 participating states, the game was suspended. While there was no top prize winner, there were 3,607 New Jersey players who took home \$27,728 in prizes ranging from \$5 to \$500 from the final draw. The winning numbers for the Friday, Dec. 26 drawing were: 16, 17, 25, 31 and 51. The property number was: 22 – Marvin Gardens.

Although tickets sales for the game have ended, current ticketholders still have the opportunity to be a contestant on the final television game show. Players can register their ticket by logging onto www.nj.playmmc.com. The deadline to enter the next TV game show drawing is January 6, 2015. The drawing to determine trip winners will take place a week later. The selected players will be flown to Las Vegas where the show will be taped and will receive a five-day, four-night stay for two, plus spending money. The trip winner travel dates to Las Vegas are February 19 – 23, 2015. Billy Gardell, star of "Mike & Molly," will serve as the host of the show.

Carole Hedinger, New Jersey Lottery Executive Director said, "All prize winners from the MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB game will be paid including trip to Las Vegas for our lucky players."

Originally conceived as a multi-tiered drawing-style game, MONOPOLY MILLIONAIRES' CLUB debuted Oct. 19 in 23 states, but sales came in below industry projections, leading the Texas Lottery Commission to suspend sales of the game in that state following the Dec. 12 drawing. Lotteries participating in the game then made the decision Dec. 22 to end all sales in its current format on Dec. 26.
