

Runners needed for NJNG marathon team

If you are a marathon runner and are interested in joining the New Jersey National Guard marathon team, please continue reading. Some information required to join the marathon team will need to be quickly submitted to National Guard Bureau.

NGB Marathon Program Time Trials for National Guard marathoners will occur May 2 through May 5, 2014 at Lincoln, Neb. The Lincoln National Guard Marathon qualification times, which must have been completed within the past 18 months, are as follows:

Men Open (Men under age 40): 4 hours, 00 minutes.

Men Masters (Men age 40 and over): 4 hours, 15 minutes.

Women (All ages): 4 hours, 30 minutes.

These are only times for qualifying for funding to attend the Lincoln National Guard Marathon at NGB expense. You may be asked for proof of completion. Criteria to make the All Guard Team are separate and will be determined on race day.

NGB Funding Authorizations: Currently each state is tentatively authorized three (3) Army Guard and three (3) Air Guard runners at NGB's expense. This funding has not been guaranteed yet so the final team makeup may change.

If you are interested in joining the NJNG marathon team, I need the following information sent back to me no later than Wednesday, Feb. 5 at 8 a.m. Once the roster is approved, I will give

team members the special registration codes and further directions to include hotel and travel information.

FAA Hiring Air Traffic Controllers

The Federal Aviation Administration has re-opened its academy for training air traffic controllers since it of the Spring of 2013.

The FAA intends to hire approximately 3,00 people over the next year for these positions across the country. In addition, the FAA anticipates that they will be hiring in significant numbers over the next several years, given the unique feature that requires air traffic controllers retire by age 56.

Below are some key points of this FAA hiring initiative:

- FAA will post these positions on the USA Jobs website from Feb. 10 to Feb. 21.
 - Recruitment will be nationwide
- Air traffic controllers range in the Pay Scale from GS 9 15, pay depending on the local area
- Individuals must start the FAA Academy or be conditionally hired by their 31st birthday

Individuals must have three (3) years of progressivesible work experience, or a Bachelor's degree, or bination of education and work experience

- Individuals must meet medical and security requirements of being a government employee
