IF YOU ARE A VETERAN AND WANT TO TALK WITH AN ATTORNEY, VLJ's VETERANS LEGAL PROGRAM MAY BE ABLE TO HELP.

If you are a veteran and:

- You have NJ criminal record,
- Your NJ driver's license is suspended,
- You are being contacted by debt collectors or are considering filing for bankruptcy,
- You are being evicted, or threatened with eviction in NJ,
- You are having issues paying an existing NJ child support order,
- Or you are looking to finalize your estate planning documents

You should contact Volunteer Lawyers for Justice (VLJ) to complete an application for FREE legal services. Eligible veterans will be scheduled to meet with an attorney via phone or video to discuss their issue.
