SUBJECT: Change to Enhanced Digital Driver License (EDDL) and Non-Driver

Identification

Beginning this week, the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission (MVC) will begin a pilot for the issuance of its updated Enhanced Digital Driver License (EDDL) and Non-Driver Identification. This rollout will include customers that receive their license via online or mail in services. The MVC is also planning several agency pilots in the coming weeks.

Although the look of the EDDL differs slightly from the existing driver license, the MVC would like to ensure that outside parties are aware of the details of this new document, which will have a phased-in issuance process beginning in November 2020. This conversion process will take several months to complete. Once all MVC Agencies are successfully converted to issue the new EDDL, the old-style will no longer be issued.
