## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021- 02**

I, B. Sue Fulton, Chair and Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, as authorized pursuant to the March 13, 2020 declaration of a national emergency under 42 U.S.C. § 5191(b) and the public health emergency declared on January 31, 2020 related to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); the Motor Vehicle Security and Customer Service Act, N.J.S.A. 39:2A-1, et seq.; N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.12; N.J.A.C. 13:21-23.10(f); N.J.A.C. 13:18-11.9; and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Waiver in Response to the COVID-19 National Emergency – For States, Commercial Driver License Holders, Commercial Driver License Permit Holders, and Interstate Drivers Operating Commercial Motor Vehicles, issued November 29, 2021; and for good cause shown, do hereby order as follows:

1. The requirement that Commercial Driver License Permit holders wait 14 days to take the commercial driver license skills test is waived through February 28, 2022.

This Order shall take effect December 1, 2021.
