ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-02

I, B. Sue Fulton, Chair and Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission, as authorized pursuant to the March 13, 2020 declaration of a national emergency under 42 U.S.C. § 5191(b) and the public health emergency declared on January 31, 2020 related to the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19); the Motor Vehicle Security and Customer Service Act, N.J.S.A. 39:2A-1, et seq.; N.J.S.A. 39:3-10.12; N.J.A.C. 13:21-23.10(f); N.J.A.C. 13:18-11.9; and the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Waiver in Response to the COVID-19 National Emergency – For States and Commercial Driver License Permit Holders Operating Commercial Motor Vehicles, issued February 26, 2022; and for good cause shown, do hereby order as follows:

1. The requirement that Commercial Driver License Permit holders wait 14 days to take the commercial driver license skills test is waived through May 31, 2022, provided the permit holder has first completed the applicable entry-level driver training requirements.

This Order shall take effect March 1, 2022.
