NOTICE TO MOBILE PAINT AND REPAIR ENTITIES

December 9, 2009

Pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 39:13-2, the Chief Administrator of the New Jersey Motor Vehicle Commission shall establish a class of licensure of auto body repair facilities based on the types of motor vehicles repaired and the equipment required for such repair. The regulations pertaining to the licensure of auto body repair facilities currently in effect do not encompass mobile paint and repair. However, the Chief Administrator intends to propose regulations in the near future addressing licensure and the types of repairs that may be performed by mobile paint and repair entities. In the interim, until those regulations are proposed and promulgated, the Commission does not deem mobile paint and repair to be prohibited and therefore such operators may continue to perform repair work on vehicles as follows: (1) vehicles owned by the public; (2) vehicles owned by the public that are being serviced by a licensed motor vehicle dealer, whether such repairs are being performed pursuant to the terms of a pre-purchased warranty program, or, whether the repair(s) are an additional service offered and purchased as part of or during the regular maintenance of a vehicle; and (3) all vehicles held in dealer inventory.

All activities conducted by mobile paint and repair entities must comply with any applicable local, State and federal laws including, but not limited to, insurance laws and regulations, zoning ordinances, and environmental rules and regulations, including, as applicable, the National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants (NESHAP), subpart HHHHHH, governing paint stripping and miscellaneous surface coating operations.
