

Municipal Plan Conformance


- The Highlands Council has received resolutions expressing a Notice of Intent from 67 of the 88 Highlands municipalities.
- This results in the potential for conformance of over 775,000 acres of the nearly 860,000 acre Highlands Region (or 87% of the Region
- Of the 88 Highlands municipalities, 77 have taken affirmative steps to address their Fair Share Plans either through an extension request with COAH, the filing of a Petition with COAH, or filing for relief with the Courts.

Municipal Plan Conformance

- **2009 Basic Plan Conformance**
 - Immediate mandatory requirements such as adopting resource protections
- 2010 onward Full PlanConformance
 - Longer-term planning requirements
 - Completed per implementation agenda/schedule
- Both steps are Plan Conformance under the Highlands Act and trigger municipal benefits



2009 Plan Conformance Grants

Modules:

- 1. Current Municipal Conditions & Build-Out Analysis
- 2. Land Use and Resource Capacity Analysis
- 3. Housing Element & Fair Share Plan
- 4. Environmental Resource Inventory
- 5. Highlands Master Plan Element
- 6. Highlands Regulations
- 7. Municipal Self-Assessment, Implementation Plan & Petition

Module 1: Current Municipal Conditions & Build-Out Analysis

- Highlands Council to provide information regarding municipal developable lands, open space/preserved farmland, conservation easements, water supply and wastewater facilities in a Geodatabase
- Municipal QA/QC of Highlands information
- Highlands Council will provide final Report and information on developable lands, utility capacity and septic system yields.

Base Grant Amount: \$15,000

Module 2: Land Use and Resource Capacity Analysis

- Municipality evaluates Module 1 results by performing a comparison of projected demands with existing conditions:
 - Septic system yield
 - Public water supply utility capacity
 - Wastewater facilities utility capacity
- Highlands Council will provide Water Availability limitations where relevant
- Perform a Limiting Factor Analysis
- Evaluate limiting factor analysis with local zoning

Base Grant Amount: \$10,000

Module 3: Housing Element & Fair Share Plan

- Incorporate results from Build-Out Analysis into updated Housing Element and Fair Share Plan
- Prepare Housing Element and Fair Share Plan reports
- Submit reports to Highlands Council to review prior to municipal adoption
- Once approved, documents should be submitted to COAH or Law Division of the Superior Court in accordance with Fair Housing Act

Base Grant Amount: \$7,500

Module 4: Environmental Resource Inventory


- Highlands Council will provide a Highlands-specific ERI narrative along with tabular data and maps for municipal consideration
- Highlands ERI may be used as stand-alone ERI or as an addendum to existing ERI
- Municipality will edit the narrative using tabular data, and may reformat the document so that it is compatible with other municipal reports

Base Grant Amount: \$2,000

Module 5: Highlands Master Plan Element

 Sample Highlands Plan Element will be provided to each municipality to evaluate and modify as appropriate

Base Grant Amount: \$2,500

Module 6: Highlands Regulations

- Municipality will evaluate existing municipal ordinances to evaluate whether they satisfy RMP conformance standards
- Sample Highlands Ordinances will be provided to each municipality to evaluate and modify as appropriate

Base Grant Amount: \$5,000

Module 7: Municipal Self-Assessment, Implementation Plan & Petition

- Highlands Council will work with municipalities to develop a Municipal Self Assessment Report and Implementation Plan for full Plan Conformance
- Highlands Council will provide a sample resolution (for Preservation Area) and sample ordinance (for Planning Area) for municipal adoption

Base Grant Amount: \$8,000

These documents, in addition to the previous module deliverables will serve as a Petition to the Highlands Council for Plan Conformance
