If you are unemployed and served after 9/11, the Gold Card offers intensive services to increase your chances of success in today's job market. (Visit *www.dol.gov/vets/goldcard.html* for more information and to print out a card.) Present your gold card at your local One-Stop Career Center, and you'll get

- first look at job openings, apprenticeship programs and other free or low-cost training opportunities
- help creating an Individual Development Plan (IDP) to map your career goals
- an evaluation of your job readiness, including interviews and testing

- career guidance through group or individual counseling
- up to 6 months of followup from a case manager to help you achieve your goals.
