At the commencement of the meeting, the Chairman, pursuant to section 5 of the Open Public Meetings Act, entered this announcement into the minutes of the meeting:

The next item for consideration was the minutes of the January 25, 2007 meeting. A motion to adopt the minutes was made by Commissioner Buchanan and seconded by Commissioner Watkins. The motion was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

The General Counsel's supplemental report was distributed and no comments were made.

The first case for consideration was Essex County College and Essex County College Faculty Association, Docket No. SN-2007-017. Commissioner Fuller moved the draft decision and Commissioner DiNardo seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

The next case for consideration was Camden County Vocational Technical Board of Education and Camden County Vocational Technical School Teachers Association, Docket No. SN-2007-024. Commissioner Watkins moved the draft decision and Commissioner DiNardo seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved

(Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

The next case for consideration was Hillsborough Township Board of Education and Hillsboro Education Association, Docket No. SN-2007-025. Commissioner Fuller moved the draft decision and Commissioner Buchanan seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

The next case for consideration was State of New Jersey Judiciary and PANJ (Case-Related Professional Unit), Docket No. SN-2007-034. Commissioner Buchanan moved the draft decision and Commissioner Fuller seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

The next case for consideration was State of New Jersey Judiciary (Cumberland Vicinage), Docket No. SN-2007-023. Commissioner Fuller moved the draft decision and Commissioner DiNardo seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).

Lastly, Chairman Henderson read a Resolution in Honor of Susan Wood Osborn who will be retiring. Commissioner Buchanan moved the Resolution and Commissioner DiNardo seconded the motion. The Resolution was unanimously approved (Chairman Henderson, Commissioners Buchanan, DiNardo, Fuller and Watkins).
