On July 6, 2010, the Public Employment Relations Commission proposed to readopt, without amendments, the rules governing the processing of contested transfer cases. In such cases, the Commission exercises its jurisdiction under N.J.S.A. 34:13A-27 to determine whether a transfer of a school board employee was for disciplinary reasons or not. If it was, the transfer is illegal.

Summary of Public Comment and Agency Response:

No comments were received and no changes were made.
