 of unappropriated lands in the Western Division of New
 Jersey, bearing date the _____ Day of _____ 1822

I have surveyed unto the said Joshua P. Brown-
 -ing - All that certain tract or piece of lands, sit-
 -uate in the Town and County of Gloucester in
 the Western Division of New Jersey, in part of the
 grant aforesaid - bounded as follows - viz - Begin-
 -ning at a Stake standing at low water mark
 in the edge of the River Delaware at the lower corner
 of late Samuel W. Harrison Esq's plantation, and
 upper corner of land late Samuel Elles's Dec. - and
 runs from thence - 1 - South fifty four degrees East
 thirty nine chains - 2 - South twenty degrees West fifty
 eight chains and fifty links - 3 - North fifty four
 degrees West forty chains - 4 - North six degrees and
 fifteen minutes East thirty five chains and fifty
 links, and - 5 - North thirty six degrees East thirty five
 chains to the place of beginning - Containing
 two hundred and seventy five acres and fifty hun-
 -dredths of an acre, and allowance for highway.

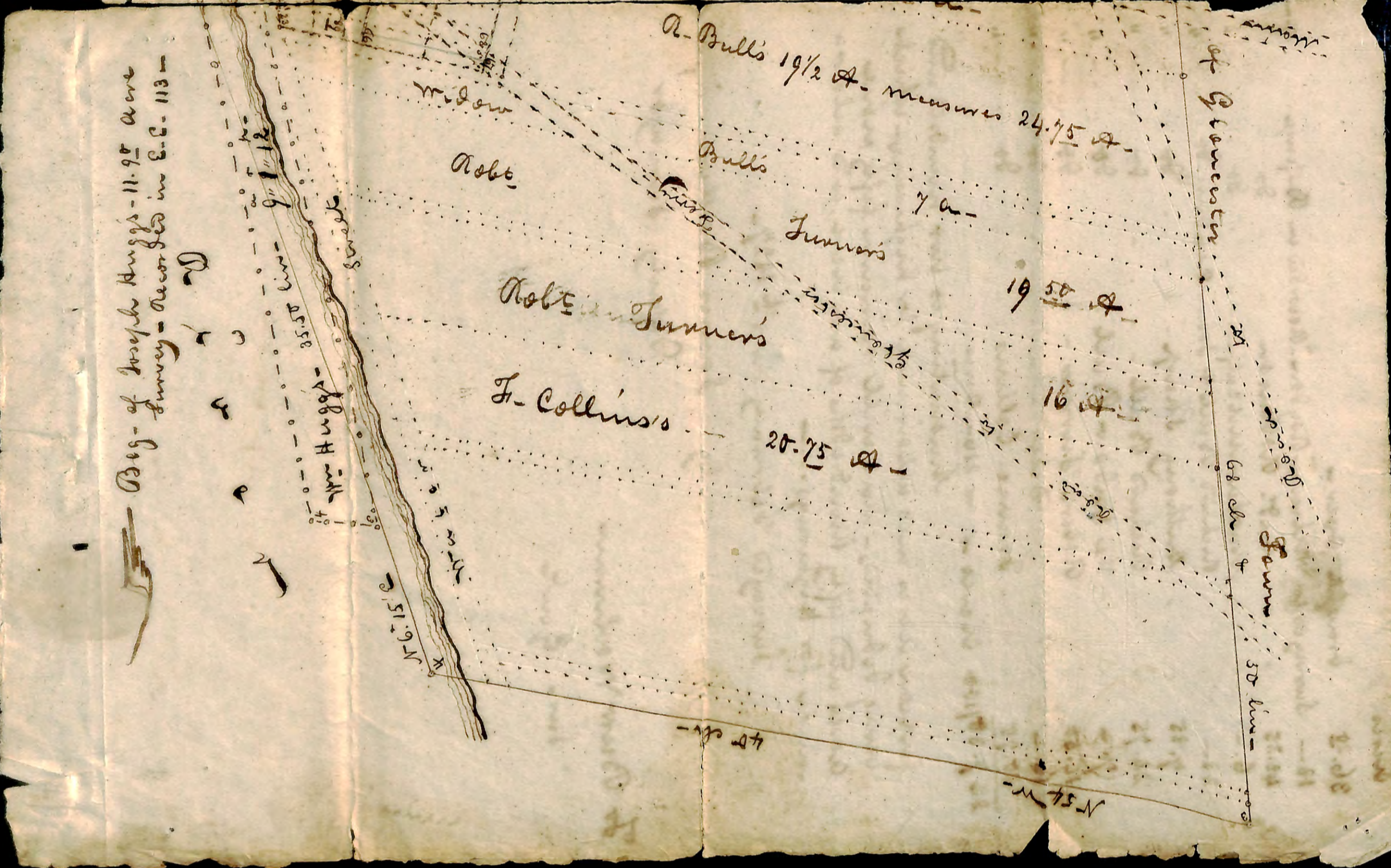
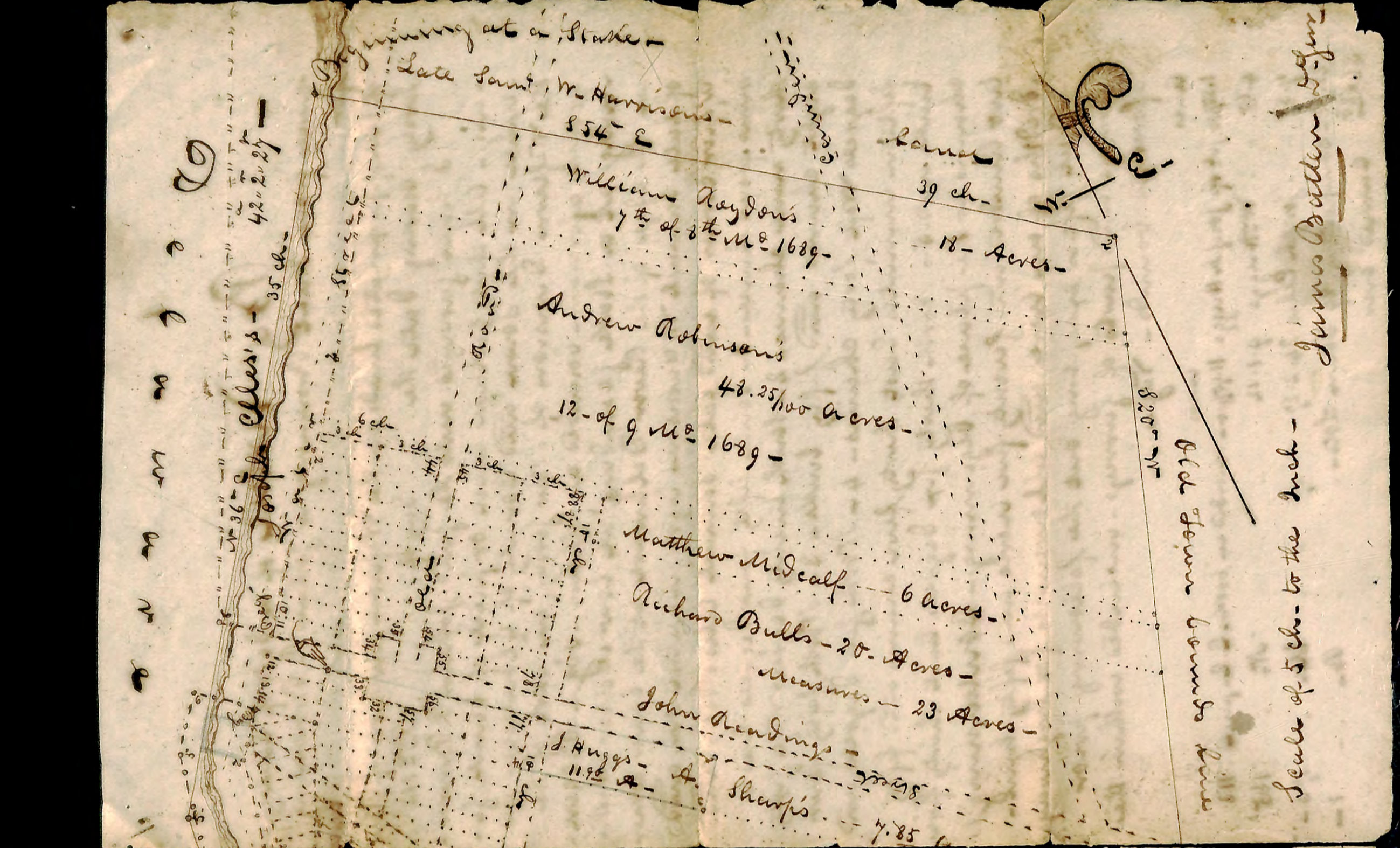

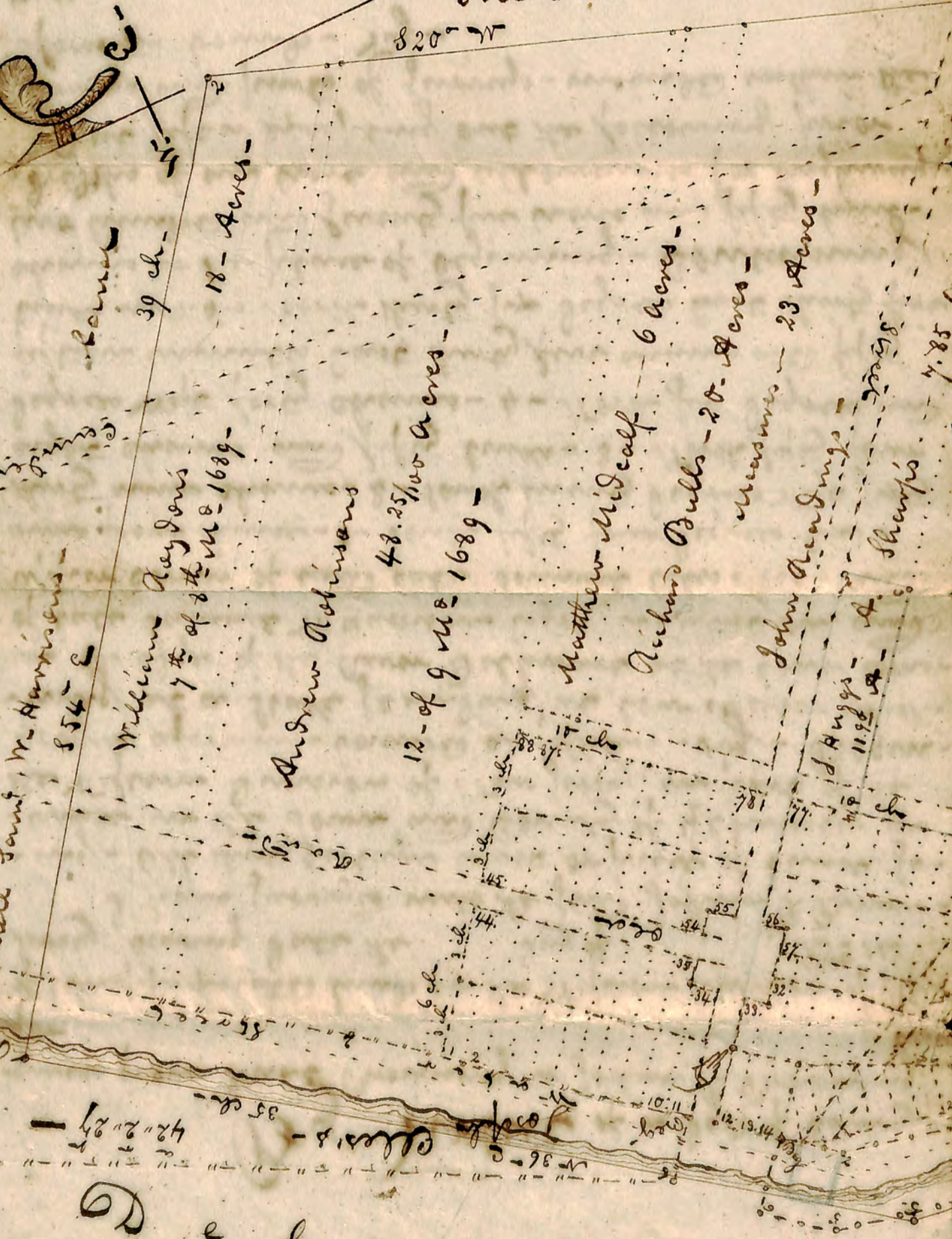
