Beginns at a certain Elm tree marked for a Corner by y<sup>e</sup> Brook next Willm Biddes land & runs  
West thirty three chains to a white oak for a Corner, then north west thirtieen chains to a  
black oak for a Corner, then west to Thomas Duggles land to a Gum tree for a Corner, then by said  
Duggles north eighteen chains to a black oak, Corner to y<sup>e</sup> said Duggles, then north north East thirty  
chains to an oak, then north north west nether twenty five chains to a white oak, then north  
North East twenty seven chains to a Hickory, then South East by East thirty chains to a stake  
then South by East forty chains to a white oak, then South South East againe to y<sup>e</sup> Brook,  
then crosses y<sup>e</sup> said Brook & up by a small run to y<sup>e</sup> end of y<sup>e</sup> old Indian purchase, then so along  
the same Southwards to y<sup>e</sup> next Brook, then by y<sup>e</sup> same bounds to y<sup>e</sup> Corner first mentioned

Corner next Sam<sup>l</sup> Buddens land, then by y<sup>e</sup> Budden north west four chains & South west near fifty
