N.J.S.A. 19:61-9: AUDIT OF ELECTION RESULTS

2022 General Election

Audit Date: November 29, 2022

The Camden County Board of Elections (CC BOE) performed an audit consistent with provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:61-9.

The Camden County Board of Elections conducted a hand-to-eye count of the voter-verifiable paper records for the General Election for U.S. House of Representatives, County Board of Commissioners, and one municipal race, where available. The additional municipal races, Board of Education, Fire Commissioner, and public questions were excluded from the audit.

Pursuant to the statute, "the audit shall be conducted in at least 2% of the election districts in which each audited election appears on the ballot." Camden County is comprised of One Congressional district. Forty-one units were chosen from Congressional District One.

Audit units included vote by mail ballots by municipality/ward and received by November 14, 2022, with a timely postmark; provisional ballots by municipality/ward, and votes cast during Early Voting on voting machines with a paper trail. Tally sheets were prepared in advance of the audit for each municipality/ward.

The selected audit units are listed on the attached spreadsheet.

The audit units contained no discrepancies. Any paper ballot which contained an overvote for a contest was recorded as an overvote but did not count any votes. The audit did not tally undervotes. The ballot scanners were set to count any circle that was colored in at 35% or more. If 12% to 25% was filled in, the machine finds that mark to be ambiguous, therefore it was sent to adjudication computers for the final decision on voter intent.
