The anticipated roadway improvements include improvements at the intersection. As part of the project, the Amwell Road/Montgomery Road/Black Point Road intersection will be improved. The intersection improvements will consist of milling, resurfacing, new concrete curb construction and drainage.

The project involves replacing the existing single-slip Colgate Ferry Barge with a four-slip ferry facility. The work will include the demolition and removal of the existing pier, building a new fixed pier and fabricating two steel floats. The estimated project cost is \$12.4 million with both public and private components. Goldman Sachs is providing \$8.25 million and NJDOT, through FTA, is providing \$4.37 million.

Also included is the construction of a 3,000 square foot terminal with berthing structure to accommodate up to six passenger vessels concurrently. An estimated 12-15,000 passenger trips per day are projected for 2004 with a capacity to handle 30,000 passengers per day. The federally funded work entails the demolition and removal of existing pier and the removal of timber piles; pipe piles and anchors will be driven along with cast-in-place concrete pile bents. Pre-cast panels and reinforced concrete topping slabs, two steel floats and aluminum metal deck will be fabricated. Dredging is not part of this project.
