The bridge has inadequate deck geometry, inadequate turning radii, substandard lane widths, and has been prioritized as a high priority for in-depth scour evaluation. Morris County will replace the existing bridge with a bridge on a new alignment that meets current width, horizontal and vertical alignment, structure capacity, and safety standards.
