The following drainage problems will be addressed through this project: Route 40, Buck Road (MP 21.80)--The improvement includes construction of a new drainage system and stormwater infiltration basin along Route 40. In addition, Route 40 will be regraded, paved and curbing replaced.

Route 42, Maxine Avenue (MP 0.60)--The project will provide for reconstruction and upgrades to the existing drainage system, including new inlets and pipes as well as the replacement of existing culverts. The open channel will be regraded to provide stability to the roadway.
