The Port Reading Junction project will create a double-track rail connection between the CSX Railroad's West Trenton Line, The Norfolk Southern Railroad's Lehigh Valley Line and Conrail's Port reading Secondary Line in the vicinity of Manville, New Jersey. Presently these lines come together in Manville in an area of single track operation. When a train from any one of these three lines occupies that single track section, movements on the other two lines are frozen until the single track segment is cleared. This project will install new track on both the Lehigh Valley and West Trenton lines, along with associated switches and rail crossovers between these tracks, creating a double-track connection which will allow two trains to operate on this section of railroad simultaneously, eliminating the delays caused by the current single track operation.
