Some of these signalized intersections have had adjustments over the past few years, however, each signalized intersection will be (re)evaluated and, if required, modified in the proposed new Road Diet design. Work will include, but not be limited too; insuring that signalized intersections have the appropriate number/type of traffic signal heads at the appropriate locations, each intersection is ADA compliant, backplates with retro reflective borders will be added to the traffic signal heads, all 8" traffic signal heads will be changed to 12", and pedestrian signal heads include countdown technology.
