John Galt Way to be closed and detoured for railroad-crossing repairs this week in Florence **Necessary safety work will require detours**

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials announced today the start of a railroad crossing rehabilitation project that will require a seven-day closure and detour of John Galt Way to start tomorrow in Florence, Burlington County.

Beginning at 7 a.m., Friday, October 4, until 7 p.m., Friday, October 18, John Galt Way will be closed and detoured in both directions at the railroad crossing between Richards Run and Route 130/Bordentown Road to remove the existing crossing and replace it with a new concrete crossing, as well as new asphalt approaches. The following detours will be in place:

John Galt Way eastbound detour

- Motorists traveling on John Galt Way eastbound will be directed to turn right onto Richards Run
- Turn left onto Dultys Lane
- Turn left onto Route 130/Bordentown Road back to John Galt Way

John Galt Way westbound detour

- Motorists wishing to travel westbound on John Galt Way will be directed to turn right onto Route 130/Bordentown Road South
- Turn right onto Dultys Lane
- Turn right onto Richards Run back to John Galt Way

The traffic detours will be coordinated with the local police. If work is completed earlier, the roadway will be reopened accordingly. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
