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Traffic shift tonight on Paterson Plank Road Bridge as replacement project advances in Secaucus One lane of alternating traffic required overnight

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a lane closure and traffic shift on Paterson Plank Road over Route 3 as the bridge replacement project advances in Secaucus, Hudson County.

Beginning at 10 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 22, NJDOT's contractor, J.F. Creamer & Son Joint Venture with Joseph M. Sanzari Inc., will close lanes on Paterson Plank Road from Maple Street to First Street with a single lane of alternating traffic in order to establish a traffic shift.

By 6 a.m. the following morning, Saturday, November 23, Paterson Plank Road traffic will be shifted from the northbound side of the bridge to the newly-reconstructed southbound side. One lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction at all times throughout this phase of construction.

During this stage of the \$8.7 million federally-funded project, the bridge superstructure on the northbound side will be demolished and replaced. This stage of construction is anticipated to be complete by fall 2020.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
