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Route 19 northbound lane closures begin tomorrow for concrete repairs in Clifton

Left lane closure will remain in place for approximately one month

(Trenton) - New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime lane closures on Route 19 northbound as a concrete repair project begins in Clifton, Passaic County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. tomorrow, Friday, January 10, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, will close the left lane of Route 19 northbound and shift the right lane into the shoulder in the vicinity of the Route 19 southbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway. One lane will be maintained while work is taking place.

By 3 p.m. Friday afternoon, the right lane will be shifted back to its normal configuration. The left lane will remain closed for approximately one month to allow for repairs to be made to the concrete piers supporting the overpass. Motorists are advised to use caution and slow down in the work area.

The work is part of a larger \$19 million state-funded maintenance project to repair and upgrade roadways in various locations in North Jersey.
