Route 206 traffic shift needed between Andria Avenue and Doctors Way as the Hillsborough Bypass project advances No lane closures will be required during this traffic shift

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a traffic shift on Route 206 in both directions between Andria Avenue and Doctors Way in Hillsborough as the Route 206 Bypass construction continues.

Beginning at 9 a.m., tomorrow, Tuesday, March 31, until 2 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, Konkus Corporation, is scheduled to shift Route 206 northbound and southbound traffic between Andria Avenue and Doctors Way toward the east side of the road. Motorists are advised to slow down and use caution in the area of the new traffic pattern as a sharp turn is required in both directions. No lanes closures are required to implement the traffic shift. This pattern will be in place for approximately two months while road work continues.

When completed, the Route 206 Hillsborough Bypass will shift through traffic onto a new 3.6-mile section of Route 206 to the east of the existing highway between Mountain View Road and Old Somerville Road, creating opportunities for the development of a town center along the current Route 206 in Hillsborough.

The 1.7-mile center section of the Bypass was built first as part of a \$44 million state-funded contract. It was completed and opened in October 2013. The \$36.6 million state and federally-funded Contract B will construct the remaining portion of the Route 206 Bypass. The project limits are from Mountain View Road to Hillsborough Road on the southern end and from Amwell Road/CR 514 to Old Somerville Road on the northern end. The entire Bypass project is on schedule and is expected to be complete in the fall 2020.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
