## **Route 23 southbound ramp to I-287 southbound to close tomorrow for additional drainage repairs in Riverdale, Morris County Detour expected to remain in place for approximately one week**

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the closure and detour of the Route 23 southbound ramp to I-287 southbound for additional drainage repairs in Riverdale, Morris County. This is a continuation of repairs that were made in March.

Beginning at 8 a.m. tomorrow, Tuesday, May 5, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close and detour the Route 23 southbound ramp to I-287 southbound to repair a collapsed drainage pipe. The following signed detour is anticipated to remain in place for approximately one week:

### **Route 23 southbound ramp to I-287 southbound detour:**

- Motorists wishing to take the ramp to I-287 southbound will be directed to continue on Route 23 southbound
- Take the next exit for I-287 northbound
- Take the first exit for Route 23 northbound
- Take the first exit for I-287 southbound

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
