I-80 eastbound Exit 34 to close tomorrow for priority bridge repairs in Wharton, Morris County Two lanes will be closed on I-80 eastbound

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures and a ramp closure on I-80 eastbound beginning Thursday for priority bridge repairs in Wharton, Morris County. This is a continuation of work that began in the area on April 23.

Beginning 8 a.m., Thursday, May 7, until 3:30 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close I-80 eastbound Exit 34 to North Main Street/CR 634 in Wharton, Morris County, for priority repairs to the bridge header. The right and center lanes on I-80 eastbound will also be closed, with one lane of traffic being maintained throughout the day. The following signed detour will be in place:

I-80 eastbound Exit 34 to North Main Street/CR 634 detour:

- Motorists wishing to take the I-80 eastbound Exit 34 to North Main Street/CR 634 will be directed to continue on I-80 eastbound
- Take Exit 35 towards Mount Hope/Dover
- Keep right at the fork to merge on to Mount Hope Avenue/CR 661
- Turn right on to Mount Pleasant Avenue
- Turn right on to Route 15/West Union Turnpike
- Use the left lane to turn on to East Dewey Avenue back to North Main Street/CR 634

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
