Route 1 ramps to Garden State Parkway north to be closed and detoured overnight this week for final striping in Woodbridge Northbound ramp to be closed and detoured

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the Route 1 ramps to the Garden State Parkway will be closed and detoured overnight this week for final striping in Woodbridge.

Beginning at 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. the next day both tonight, Wednesday, May 27 and tomorrow, Thursday, May 28, the New Jersey Turnpike Authority's contractor, Northeast Remsco, will close and detour the Route 1 northbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway northbound in Woodbridge for final striping. The southbound ramp will remain open with the lane narrowed to allow for a work zone to restripe the ramp. Both ramps from Route 1 to the Garden State Parkway northbound were repaved last week. The following detour will be in place:

Route 1 northbound ramp to Garden State Parkway northbound:

- Motorists wishing to take the Route 1 northbound ramp to the Garden State Parkway northbound will be directed to continue on Route 1 northbound
- Stay in the right lane and take the Gill Road U-turn exit
- Stay right for Gill Road U-turn
- Immediate merge into the left lanes for Route 1 south to Garden State Parkway north
- Turn left onto Route 1 south
- Take the ramp to the Garden State Parkway north

Variable Message Signs will provide advance notification to motorists of the traffic pattern changes associated with the work. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
