Route 82 eastbound ramp to Route 22 eastbound to be closed and detoured for two nights in Union Township Scheduled closures continue for bridge deck maintenance work

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today are reminding motorists that the Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound ramp to Route 22 eastbound will be closed and detoured tonight and tomorrow night for concrete repair work in Union, Union County. Overnight closures are scheduled to continue for approximately two months, typically occurring on Thursday nights.

Beginning at 8 p.m., tonight, Thursday, August 20, until 5 a.m., and again at 8 p.m., Friday, August 21, until 5 a.m., NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close and detour the Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound ramp to Route 22 eastbound for concrete bridge deck and structural repairs. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound ramp to Route 22 eastbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound wishing to take the ramp to Route 22 eastbound will be directed to continue on Route 82/Morris Avenue eastbound
- Take the jughandle across from the Lowe's Home Store to make a U-turn onto Route 82 westbound
- Take Route 82 westbound and take the ramp for Garden State Parkway/Route 22
- Stay right at the fork to Route 22 eastbound

If work is completed early, the ramp will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
