Route 202 lane closures this weekend for emergency drainage pipe replacement in West Amwell, Hunterdon County One lane will be maintained in each direction throughout the weekend

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 202 in both directions this weekend for emergency drainage pipe replacement in West Amwell, Hunterdon County.

Beginning at 7 p.m. tonight, September 11, until 7 p.m. Sunday, September 13, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, Inc., is scheduled to close both lanes on Route 202 southbound and the left lane on Route 202 northbound approximately one mile north from the ramp to Route 29. These closures will allow the contractor to replace a damaged drainage pipe underneath the roadway. One lane of southbound traffic will be maintained in the right shoulder, and one lane of northbound traffic will be maintained in the right lane.

Oversize loads wider than 8-foot, 6-inches will be prohibited from traveling on this section of Route 202 southbound while the lane closures are in place.

If work is completed early, the road will reopen sooner. The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
