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Route 94 lane closures tomorrow as Bridge over Blair Creek maintenance project is completed in Blairstown Alternating traffic will be in place during the day

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime lane closures on the Route 94 Bridge over Blair Creek as a bridge maintenance project is completed in Blairstown, Warren County.

Beginning at 7 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, October 7, NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is scheduled to close the northbound lane on Route 94 at the Bridge over Blair Creek and set up an alternating traffic pattern in the southbound lane. Later that day, the northbound lane will reopen with alternating traffic, and the southbound lane will be closed. These closures will allow the contractor to remove construction barrier from both sides of the roadway.

By 3 p.m. that afternoon, both lanes will reopen and the roadway will be restored to its original configuration, with one lane in each direction.

The project, which made repairs to the bridge piers, is part of a larger \$7 million state-funded maintenance contract to repair timber, concrete and drainage structures in eight counties throughout North Jersey.

Variable messaging signs are being utilized to provide advance notification to the motoring public of all traffic pattern changes associated with the work. NJDOT will provide more information before any lane closures are scheduled.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
