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Route 9 northbound ramp to I-195 westbound to be closed and detoured tonight in Howell Closure required to replace drainage pipe under the roadway

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced that the ramp from Route 9 northbound to I-195 westbound will be closed and detoured overnight for drainage pipe repairs in Howell, Monmouth County

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Friday, October 9 until 4:30 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, October 10, NJDOT's Contractor, I.E.W., is scheduled to close and detour the ramp from Route 9 northbound to I-195 westbound. This closure will allow the contractor to replace a damaged drainage pipe underneath the roadway. The following signed detour will be in place overnight:

Route 9 northbound to I-195 westbound detour:

- Motorists traveling on Route 9 northbound wishing to take the ramp to I-195 westbound will be directed to turn right on Aldrich Road, which comes before the ramp to I-195 westbound
- Turn left on Pinewood Road
- Turn left on Windeler Road
- Turn left on Georgia Tavern Road
- Turn left onto Route 9 southbound
- Take the ramp to I-195 westbound

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
