Route 34 overnight lane closures continue as paving project advances in Monmouth County **Alternating traffic pattern required for milling and paving**

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures with alternating traffic on Route 34 as a paving project advances in Aberdeen, Colts Neck, Freehold, Holmdel, and Marlboro, Monmouth County.

Beginning at 7 p.m., tonight, Thursday, October 15, until 7 a.m. the next day, Friday, October 16, and continuing overnight Monday through Thursday, October 22, NJDOT's contractor, Earle Asphalt, is scheduled close lanes with alternating traffic on Route 34 between Schanck Road, Freehold and Van Brackle Road, Holmdel for milling and paving of the roadway.

The project began last week on Route 34 at Conover Road in Colts Neck with paving completed on more than one mile to Newman Springs Road.

The work is part of a \$10.5 million state-funded project to repave five-miles of Route 34 in Aberdeen, Colts Neck, Freehold, Holmdel, and Marlboro. It also includes paving on segments of Route 79 throughout various towns in Monmouth County.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
