## **I-78 westbound Exit 29 to I-287/Routes 202 and 206 closed and detoured for emergency sign structure repairs in Bedminster Overhead sign structure damaged by tractor trailer crash**

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced I-78 westbound Exit 29 to I-287/Route 202 and 206 is closed for emergency overhead sign structure repairs in Bedminster.

The I-78 westbound Exit 29 was closed early Sunday morning following a tractor trailer crash that damaged the overhead sign structure and guiderail. NJDOT crews and contractors are working to make repairs. The work is tentatively expected to be completed tonight. If work is completed early, the roadway will reopen sooner. The following detour is in place:

### **I-78 westbound Exit 29 to I-287 and Route 202/206 detour:**

- Motorists on I-78 westbound wishing to take Exit 29 for I-287 and Route 202/206 will be directed to continue on I-78 westbound
- Take Exit 26
- Turn left at the end of the ramp onto Rattlesnake Bridge Road
- Cross over I-78 and turn left onto the ramp for I-78 eastbound
- Stay right on I-78 eastbound and take Exit 29 for I-287 and Route 202/206
