## **Route 3 eastbound lanes closed for emergency bridge repairs to Hepburn Road overpass in Clifton**

### **Two out of three lanes closed. Ramp from Garden State Parkway remains open**

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced Route 3 eastbound left and center lanes are closed for emergency bridge repairs to the Hepburn Road overpass in Clifton.

The Route 3 eastbound left and center lanes were closed today for emergency concrete repairs to the Hepburn Road Bridge over Route 3, which is just past the interchange with the Garden State Parkway. NJDOT's contractor, IEW Construction Group, is working to remove loose concrete and make repairs. The right lane and the ramp from the Garden State Parkway to Route 3 eastbound are not affected at this time and remain open. Route 3 westbound also is unaffected at this time. The work is expected to affect the evening commute. Motorists are advised to use caution, slow down and expect delays.
