## Route 1&9 Truck northbound overnight lane closures tonight for roadway resurfacing in Kearny Additional overnight lane and ramp closures will be required next week

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane and ramp closures on Route 1&9 Truck northbound as a roadway resurfacing project begins in Kearny, Hudson County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, November 13 until 5 a.m. Saturday, November 14, NJDOT's contractor, Della Pello Paving, Inc., is scheduled to close two lanes on Route 1&9 Truck northbound between Jacobus Avenue and Hackensack Avenue in Kearny to resurface the roadway. At least one lane of northbound traffic will be maintained overnight. Motorists should expect delays and are advised to avoid the area.

Additional overnight lane and ramp closures with detours will be required on Route 1&9 Truck northbound next week as resurfacing work progresses. NJDOT will provide advance notice prior to any additional closures.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
