Route 1&9 Truck overnight lane closures tonight for high priority repairs in Kearny Left lanes will be closed in each direction to repair damaged drainage inlet

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced overnight lane closures on Route 1&9 Truck in each direction for high priority repairs in Kearny, Hudson County.

Beginning at 9 p.m. tonight, Wednesday, November 18, until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Thursday, November 19, NJDOT's contractor, Della Pello Paving, Inc., is scheduled to close the left lanes on Route 1&9 Truck in each direction between Hackensack Avenue and Central Avenue. These closures will allow the contractor to repair a damaged drainage inlet underneath the roadway. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction overnight.

The Route 1&9 Truck northbound right lane and ramp closures that were previously scheduled for tonight will be postponed. They are scheduled to resume Thursday night, weather permitting.
