Route 1&9 Truck northbound daytime lane closures Thursday for high priority repairs in Kearny Left lane will be closed to repair damaged drainage inlet

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced daytime lane closures on Route 1&9 Truck northbound for high priority repairs in Kearny, Hudson County.

Beginning at 9 a.m. Thursday, December 10, until 3 p.m., NJDOT's contractor, Della Pello Paving, Inc., is scheduled to close the left lane on Route 1&9 Truck northbound between Hackensack Avenue and Central Avenue. This closure will allow the contractor to complete repairs on a damaged drainage inlet underneath the roadway. Two lanes of traffic will be maintained throughout the day, and the ramps to Hackensack Avenue and Central Avenue will remain open.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
