## I-295 eastbound/Scudder Falls Bridge lane closures will affect Wednesday morning commute Jersey-bound motorists should expect heavy congestion and delays

**(Trenton)** – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials are advising motorists to expect heavy congestion tomorrow morning on the I-295 eastbound/Scudder Falls Bridge towards New Jersey because of lane closures as part of the <u>Scudder Falls Bridge</u> Replacement project.

Beginning at approximately 6 a.m. tomorrow, Wednesday, May 26, until 10 a.m., the Delaware River Joint Bridge Toll Commission (DRJBTC), which owns and operates the bridge and is conducting the replacement project, is scheduled to close one lane on the I-295 eastbound/Scudder Falls Bridge towards New Jersey. One lane of eastbound traffic will be maintained.

The DRJBTC is anticipating delays of an hour or more for New Jersey-bound traffic and is suggesting motorists consider alternate routes.
