Smith Street/CR 656 ramp to Route 440 northbound to be closed overnight for bridge repairs in Woodbridge Closure required for concrete repairs

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced the ramp from Smith Street/CR 656 to Route 440 northbound will be closed and detoured tonight as a bridge repair project advances in Woodbridge, Middlesex County.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tonight, Friday, June 11 until 5 a.m. tomorrow, Saturday, June 12, NJDOT's contractor, Power Concrete, is scheduled to close the ramp from Smith Street/CR 656 to Route 440 northbound. This closure will allow the contractor to complete concrete repairs on the ramp. The ramp from Smith Street/CR 656 to Route 9 northbound will remain open. Motorists are advised to follow the signed detour or plan an alternate route.

The work is part of a \$6.5 million federally-funded project to maintain and repair 36 bridges at various locations throughout Middlesex and Somerset counties.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
