Route 1&9 Truck lane closures this weekend to repair the Passaic River Bridge between Kearny & Newark At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced lane closures on Route 1&9 Truck in both directions between Newark and Kearny this weekend as repairs to the bridge across the Passaic River continue.

Beginning at 8 p.m. tomorrow, Friday, June 18 until 6 a.m. Monday, June 21, NJDOT's contractor, I.E.W. Construction Group, is scheduled to close the left lanes on Route 1&9 Truck in both directions between Doremus Avenue in Newark and Jacobus Avenue in Kearny. These closures will allow the contractor to install barrier sliding plates on the Bridge over the Passaic River. At least one lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions throughout the weekend.
