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Route 130 southbound traffic shift required Monday as roadway improvement project advances in Carneys Point, Salem County Shift required to install barrier curb

(Trenton) – New Jersey Department of Transportation (NJDOT) officials today announced a traffic shift on Route 130 southbound as a roadway improvement project advances in Carneys Point, Salem County.

Beginning at 6 a.m. Monday, June 21, NJDOT's contractor, Richard E. Pierson Construction Co., is scheduled to shift traffic on Route 130 southbound to the left between Springfield Road and CR 130/Hawks Hill Road. This traffic shift will allow the contractor to install construction barrier, creating a work zone to complete a full-box reconstruction of the roadway. This traffic pattern is anticipated to remain in place for approximately three weeks. One lane of traffic will be maintained in both directions at all times.

The precise timing of the work is subject to change due to weather or other factors.
